How to find us

Road Travel

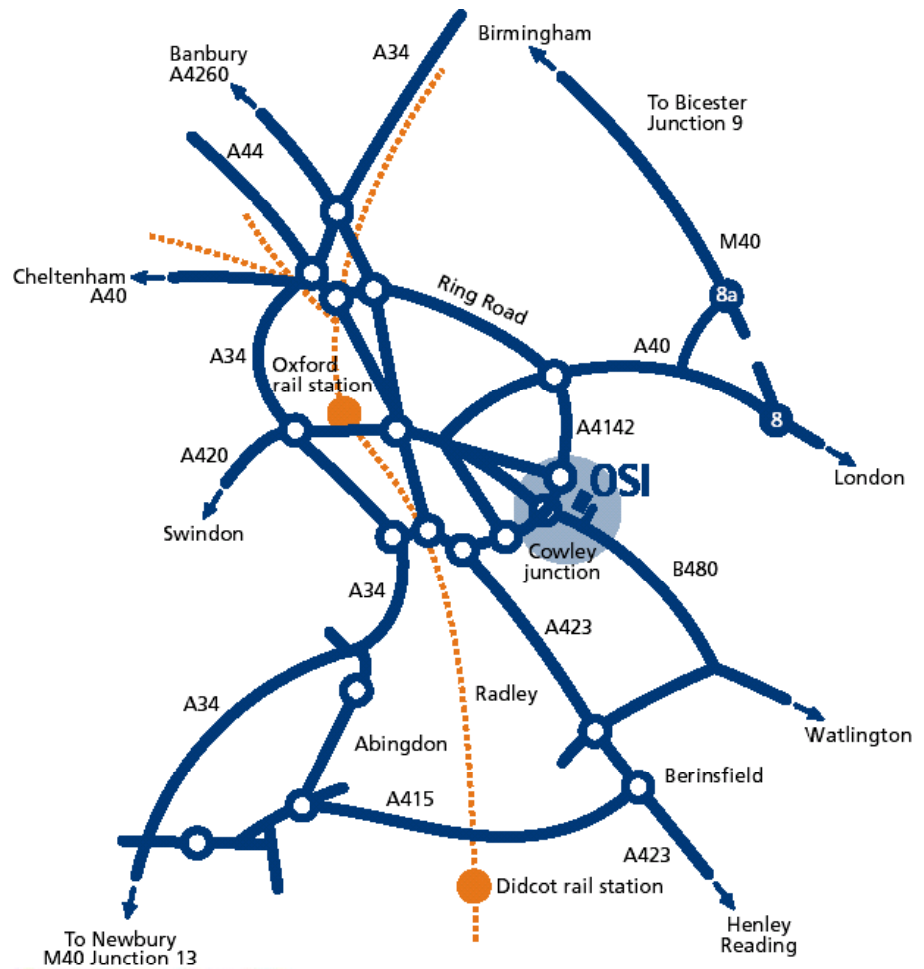
Oxford is easily accessible from the M40 and M4 motorways, A34, A420, A40 and A44 trunk roads. From the M40 southbound travellers should take J8a and northbound travellers should use J8 to access the A40 into Oxford. On reaching the outskirts of the city, take the Oxford Ring Road (A4142) to the Cowley junction. Following signs, leave the Ring Road before the flyover, towards Watlington (B480) and Blackbird Leys. Continue for half a mile. Turn left at the first set of traffic lights, and OSI Pharmaceuticals will be on your left. Visitors' car parking is provided at the far end of Windrush Court.

Public Transport

The main termini for all public transport are in Oxford City Centre.

By Rail

A regular service departs London Paddington to Oxford (journey time about one hour).

By Coach

Coaches from most major towns and cities serve Oxford's Gloucester Green coach station. From London, the Oxford "Citylink X90" runs every 20 minutes from Victoria coach station and Marble Arch. Also, the "Oxford Tube" (Stagecoach Oxford) runs every 10 minutes at peak times and every 15-20 minutes at other times. London stops include Victoria and Marble Arch.

Airport Services

The Oxford "Citylink X70" runs from Heathrow to Oxford's Gloucester Green coach station (journey time 60-70 minutes). "Citylink X80" runs from Gatwick (journey time 120 minutes). Birmingham International Airport has its own train station with direct connections to Oxford rail station. To complete your journey a taxi is recommended (distance 3.5 miles, journey time about 20 minutes).

On Arrival

All visitors should report to Windrush Court reception at the front of the building on Transport Way.
